Donkeys!

"But God has chosen the foolish things of the world to shame the wise, and God has chosen the weak things of the world to shame the things which are strong," 1 Cor. 2:27

In 1st century Rome, the wealthy and noble class were called Patricians, which comprised a tiny percentage of the population, estimated to be around 1-5%. The majority of the population were called plebeians (the common people). In addition, the slaves in the city of Rome made up 20-30% of its population. This population makeup was indicative all over the empire, including Corinth. We have examples of wealthy people becoming Christians. Philemon owned slaves, and Lydia was a successful business owner. However, most Christians did not fall into the upper 5%. This caused many to consider the early Christians as being foolish and weak.

In his letter to the church in Corinth, Paul explained how Jesus death on the cross was foolish to the Greeks and a stumbling block to the Jews. The Jews viewed the cross as a stumbling block because they believed the Messiah would overthrow the Romans and establish His kingdom on earth. How could Jesus be the Messiah if He died on a tree? The Scriptures taught in Deuteronomy 21:23 that a man hanged on a tree was cursed. The cross was foolish to the Greeks because they believed their gods would never die for them. They think that any god who could or would die on a cross to save people would be foolish and weak. Therefore, anyone who would believe such a thing would be foolish and weak. The term used for "foolishness" here is the same one behind the English word moron.

Paul is not saying that the believers in Corinth are truly foolish and weak. The world sees them as idiots and losers because they occupy service positions, are not well-educated, or do not have money, rank, or social standing.

Even more so, the world sees them as fools for believing in Jesus. In truth, though, by God's grace, these believers are the only ones who see clearly enough to receive what is actually wise and strong.

Remembering that God uses the weak and foolish for His glory is good because we don't have to be among the rich and famous to be used by God. However, we must not think pridefully about God using us for His glory. Remember, God even used a donkey to speak (Numbers 22:21-39).

I am daily more and more convinced that the difference between one man and another, is not the difference between his use of his will—but the difference of grace that has been bestowed upon him.

"Hallelujah! For our Lord God Almighty reigns!" Revelation 19:6 Stephen Charnock: "The great controversy between God and man has been, whether He or they shall be God; whether His reason or theirs, His will or theirs, shall be the guiding principle. If anything could frustrate God's will—then it would be superior to Him, God would not be omnipotent, and so would lose the perfection of the Deity, and consequently the Deity itself; for that which did wholly defeat God's will, would be more powerful than He.
