Doubting God!

Jesus said to him, "Again, it is written, 'You shall not put the Lord your God to the test." Matthew 4:7

Have you ever heard someone say, "I need to make a decision, so I laid a fleece out before the Lord"? They are referring to the events of Gideon in Judges 6. We are told the Lord was angry with the Israelites for falling into sin and worshipping false gods. As punishment for their disobedience, the Lord left them under the control of the Midianites for seven years. Seeing relief, the Israelites called out to God for help. God answered them and chose Gideon to save His people.

An angel appears before Gideon, saying (in v 14, we are told it is Yahweh Himself), "The Lord is with you, mighty warrior." The Lord then proceeds to tell Gideon that he will deliver the Israelites from the Midianites, to which point Gideon says, "O Lord, with what shall I save Israel? Behold, my clan is the least in Manasseh, and I am the youngest in my father's house". Gideon then asks the angel for a sign to prove that he is speaking with God, leaves, and returns with an offering of food. The angel then spontaneously combusts the food. Gideon then realizes it is indeed the Lord. The same night the Lord tells Gideon to destroy one of his father's altars to an idol, Baal, and replace it with an altar to God and sacrifice a bull on it. Gideon does so and at night so that he is not caught. The townspeople find out Gideon did this and demand his execution. However, Gideon's father, Joash, exclaimed that if Baal were truly a God, he would be able to defend himself. Gideon then calls to arms to fight against the Midianites several other peoples, and they join him. Then Gideon asks for another sign that God is with them and asks God to make fleece the only wet thing on the ground the next morning, and then the only dry thing on the ground the morning after that. God does both of these and Gideon knows God is with them.

Gideon goes on to defeat the Midianites with 300 warriors. (I encourage you to read the whole story in Judges 6-7). This sounds like a great outcome, but there is one big problem. Gideon sinned when he tested God. When Satan tempted Jesus, His response was to quote Deuteronomy 6:16, "You shall not put Yahweh your God to the test, as you tested Him at Massah."

When you test God, you say you don't trust His Word and reveal in immature faith. Testing God to see whether or not He is faithful, or attempting to blackmail God by making Him give you a sign on your timetable and specifications, is a pagan notion that shows a lack of trust in the God who has only ever proven entirely faithful. Kevin DeYoung stated, "we don't need dreams, visions, fleeces, and signs to know God's will. He has already revealed His plan for our lives: to love Him with our whole hearts, to obey His Word, and after that, to do what we like."


